





# RESURRECTION SUNDAY

**Rom 1:4** declared *to be* the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead.

## **Rom 4:25**

was delivered up because of our offenses, and was  
raised for of our justification

## **2 Corinthians 4:14**

He, who raised the Lord Jesus, will raise us also







## **Isaiah 53:6**

His grave was assigned to be with wicked men, but He was with a rich man in His death

## **Matt 27:57 – 61**

Now when evening had come, there came a rich man called Joseph of Arimathea, who himself was also waiting for the kingdom of God and had also become a disciple of Jesus. He went to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, and laid it in his new tomb which he had hewn out of the rock; and he rolled a large stone against the door of the tomb, and departed.



## Matt 27:62 – 64

On the next day, chief priests and Pharisees gathered together to Pilate, saying, “Sir, we remember, while He was still alive, how that deceiver said, ‘After three days I will rise.’ Therefore command that the tomb be made secure until the third day, lest His disciples come by night and steal Him *away*, and say to the people, ‘He has risen from the dead.’

## **Matt 28:2-4**

an angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door, and sat on it. His countenance was like lightning, and his clothing as white as snow. And the guards shook for fear of him, and became like dead *men*.

## **Matt 28:11-13**

guards came into the city and reported to the chief priests all the things that had happened. When they had assembled with the elders and consulted together, they gave a large sum of money to the soldiers, saying, “Tell them, ‘His disciples came at night and stole Him *away* while we slept.’”

## John 20:1-2

Now on the first *day* of the week Mary Magdalene went to the tomb early, while it was still dark, and saw *that* the stone had been taken away from the tomb.

Then she ran and came to Simon Peter, and to the other disciple, whom Jesus loved, and said to them, “They have taken away the Lord out of the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid Him.”



**Luke 24:3-8** they went in and did not find the body. As they were greatly troubled, two men stood by them in shining garments who said to them, “Why do you seek the living among the dead? **He is not here, but is risen!** Remember how He spoke to you when He was still in Galilee, saying, ‘The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again.’” And they remembered His words.

## Matt 28:5-8

“Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek Jesus who was crucified. **He is not here; for He is risen**, as He said. **Come, see the place where the Lord lay**. And go quickly and tell His disciples that He is risen from the dead, and indeed He is going before you into Galilee; there you will see Him. Behold, I have told you.” So they went out quickly from the tomb with fear and great joy, and ran to bring His disciples word.

## Luke 24:9-12

Then they returned from the tomb and told all these things to the eleven and to all the rest. <sup>10</sup> It was Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Mary *the mother* of James, and the other *women* with them, who told these things to the apostles. <sup>11</sup> And **their words seemed to them like idle tales, and they did not believe them.** But Peter arose and ran to the tomb; and stooping down, he saw the linen cloths lying by themselves; and he departed, wondering to himself at what had happened.

**John 20:3-7** Peter therefore went out, and the other disciple, and went to the tomb. <sup>4</sup> So they both ran together, and the other disciple outran Peter and came to the tomb first. <sup>5</sup> And he, stooping down and looking in, saw the linen cloths lying *there*; yet he did not go in. <sup>6</sup> Then Simon Peter came, following him, and went into the tomb; and he saw the linen cloths lying *there*, <sup>7</sup> and the handkerchief that had been around His head, not lying with the linen cloths, but folded together in a place by itself.



**John 20:8-9** Then the other disciple, who came to the tomb first, went in also; and he saw and believed. <sup>9</sup> For as yet they did not know the Scripture, that He must rise again from the dead.

**John 20:11-14** But Mary stood outside by the tomb weeping and she stooped down and looked inside. She saw two angels in white sitting, one at the head and one at the feet, where the body had lain. Then they said, “Woman, why are you weeping?” She said, “Because they have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid Him” and turned around and saw Jesus standing there, and did not know that it was Jesus. Jesus said, “Woman, why do you weep? Whom are you seeking?”

**John 20:15-18** She, thinking he was the gardener, “Sir, if You have taken him, tell me where You have laid Him, I will take Him away. Jesus said to her, “Mary!” She turned and said to Him, “Teacher” Jesus said to her, “Do not cling to Me, for I have not yet ascended to My Father; but go to My brethren and say to them, ‘I am ascending to My Father and your Father, and to My God and your God.’” Mary Magdalene came and told the disciples that she had seen the Lord, and that He had spoken these things to her.

**Matt 28:9-10** And as they went to tell His disciples,<sup>[b]</sup> behold, Jesus met them, saying, “Rejoice!” So they came and held Him by the feet and worshiped Him. Then Jesus said to them, “Do not be afraid. Go *and* tell My brethren to go to Galilee, and there they will see Me.



**Luke 24:11** these words seemed like idle tales, and they did not believe them

**Mark 16:11** when they heard He was alive, and had been seen by her, they did not believe

**Luke 24:21-24** What kind of conversation is this that you have with one another as you walk and are sad?”  
“We were hoping that it was He who was going to redeem Israel. Indeed, besides all this, today is the third day since these things happened. Yes, and certain women of our company, who arrived at the tomb early, astonished us. When they did not find His body, they came saying that they had also seen a vision of angels who said He was alive. And certain of those who were with us went to the tomb and found it just as the women had said; but Him they did not see.”

**Luke 24:32** Did not our heart burn within us while He talked with us on the road, and while He opened the Scriptures to us?” 33 So they rose up that very hour and returned to Jerusalem, and found the eleven and those who were with them gathered together, 34 saying, “The Lord is risen indeed, and has appeared to Simon!” 35 And they told about the things that had happened on the road, and how He was known to them in the breaking of bread.

## **Luke 24:36-40**

Now as they said these things, Jesus Himself stood in the midst of them, and said to them, “Peace to you.” But they were terrified and frightened, and supposed they had seen a spirit. And He said to them, “Why are you troubled? And why do doubts arise in your hearts? Behold My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself. Handle Me and see, for a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see I have.” When He had said this, He showed them His hands and His feet



## **John 20:19**

Then, the same day at evening, being the first *day* of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in the midst, and said to them, “Peace *be* with you.”

**20:20** When He had said this, He showed them His hands and His side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord.

## Luke 24:46-49

Then He said to them, “Thus it is written, and thus it was **necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day**, and that repentance and forgiveness of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. And **you are witnesses of these things**. Behold, I send the Promise of My Father upon you; but tarry in the city of Jerusalem until you are endued with power from on high

## John 20:24-25

Now Thomas was not with them when Jesus came. The other disciples therefore said to him, “We have seen the Lord.” So he said to them, “**Unless I see** in His hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and put my hand into His side, **I will not believe.**”

**John 20:26-29** And after eight days His disciples were again inside, and Thomas with them. Jesus came, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, “Peace to you!” Then He said to Thomas, “Reach your finger here, and look at My hands; and reach your hand here and put it into My side. Do not be unbelieving but believing.” And Thomas answered and said to Him, “My Lord and my God!” Jesus said to him, “Thomas, because you have seen Me, you have believed. **Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed.**”

## **John 20:30-31**

And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.



## **Romans 10:9**

If you confess Him as Lord and  
**believe in your heart**
