







Timeline of the Kingdoms of Israel and Judah




After Solomon, the kingdom was divided into TWO parts:


THE NORTHERN KINGDOM

under King Jeroboam. Its capital was located in Samaria. This kingdom is called the <u>kingdom of ISRAEL</u>.

THE SOUTHERN KINGDOM

under King Rehoboam (Solomon's son). Its capital was located in Jerusalem. This kingdom is called the <u>kingdom of JUDAH</u>. All the kings of Judah descended from King David.





Comparison

2 Chronicles 36:22-23

- ²² In the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, in order to fulfill the word of the LORD spoken by Jeremiah, the LORD moved the heart of Cyrus king of Persia to make a proclamation throughout his realm and also to put it in writing:
- ²³ "This is what Cyrus king of Persia says:
- "The LORD, the God of heaven, has given me all the kingdoms of the earth and he has appointed me to build a temple for him at Jerusalem in Judah. Any of his people among you may go up, and may the LORD their God be with them."

Ezra(1:1-3)

- ¹ In the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, in order to fulfill the word of the LORD spoken by Jeremiah, the LORD moved the heart of Cyrus king of Persia to make a proclamation throughout his realm and also to put it in writing: ² "This is what Cyrus king of Persia says:
- "The LORD, the God of heaven, has given me all the kingdoms of the earth and he has appointed me to build a temple for him at Jerusalem in Judah.³ Any of his people among you may go up to Jerusalem in Judah and build the temple of the LORD, the God of Israel, the God who is in Jerusalem, and may their God be with them.





SAUL& DAVID

1 Chron 10:13-14 So Saul died for his unfaithfulness; he was unfaithful to the Lord in that he did not keep the command of the Lord, and also consulted a medium, seeking guidance, and did not seek guidance from the Lord. Therefore the Lord slew him, and turned the kingdom over to David the son of Jesse.
