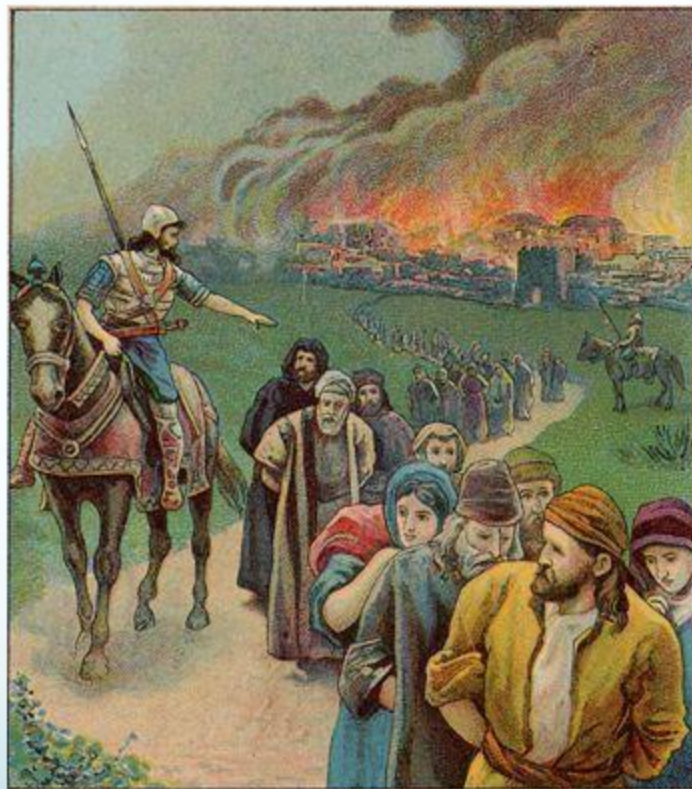

2 Chron. 36: 11-21.

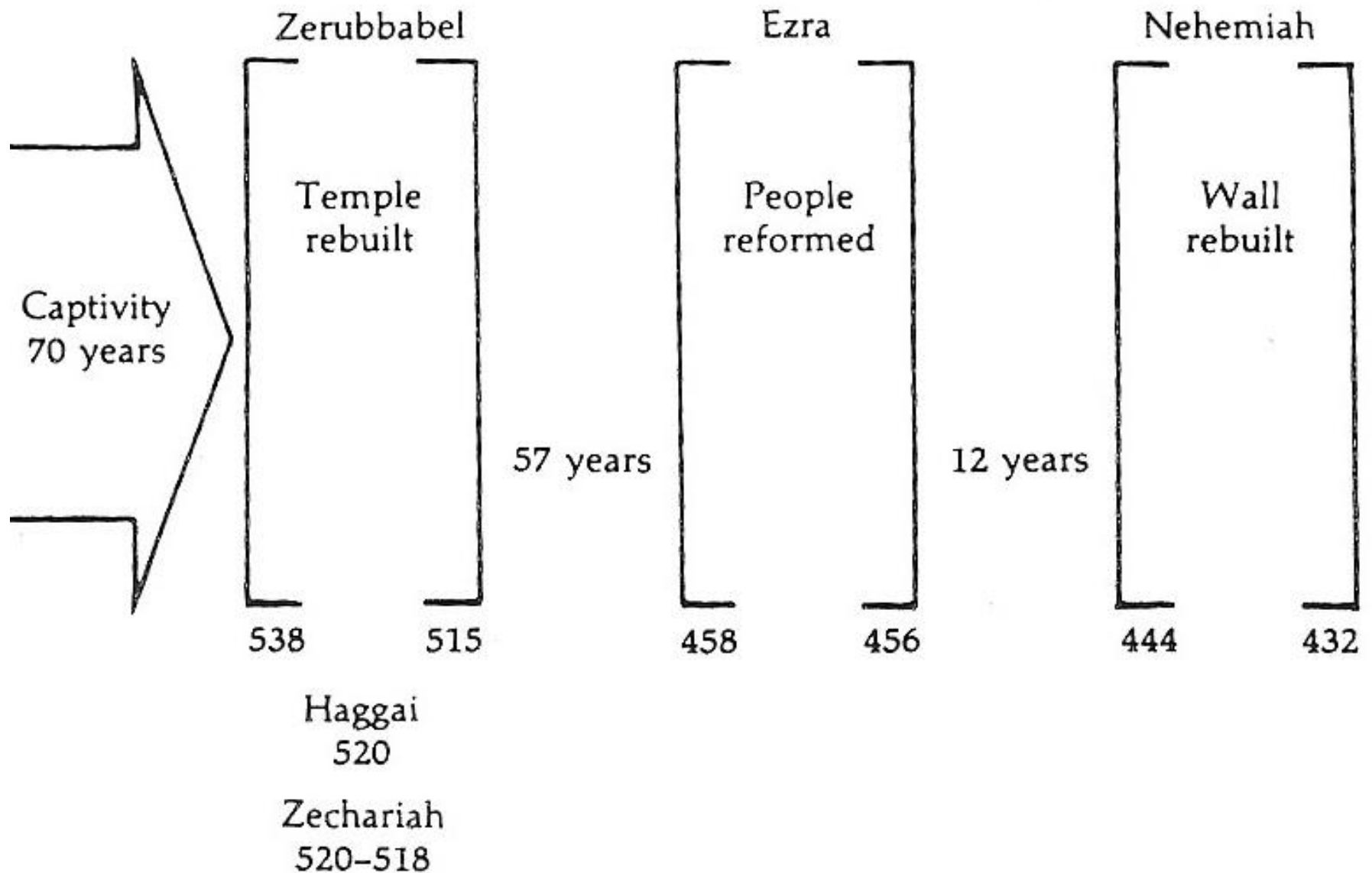
2 Kings 25:8-21; 2 Chronicles 36:17-21

- Burned the house of God, all the king's palaces, all houses in Jerusalem.
- Broke down the wall of Jerusalem.
- Carried the people to Babylon to serve the king of Babylon.

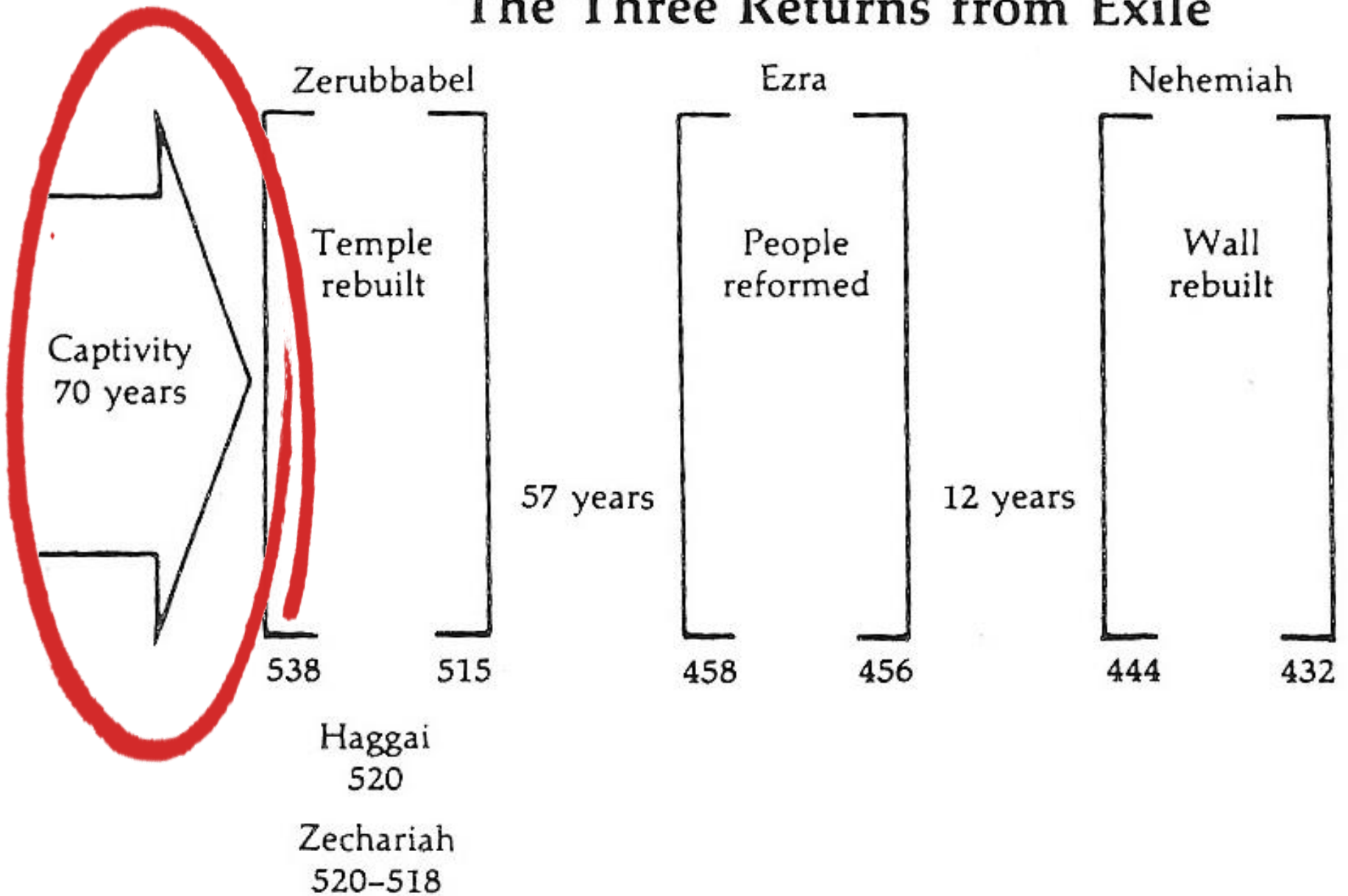

586 (nineteenth year)*	Third	Jerusalem (2 K. 25:8; Jer. 52:29)

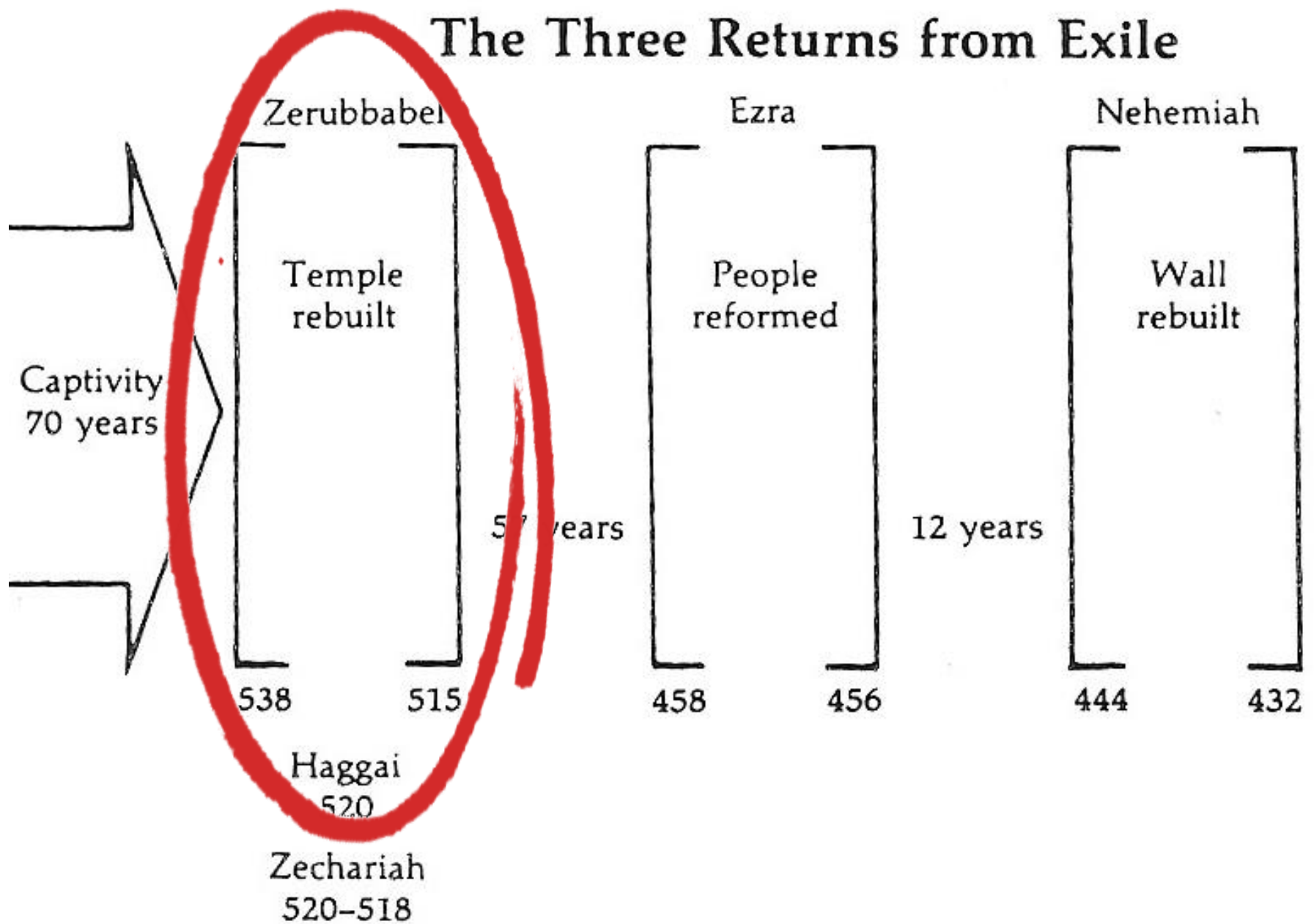
