




#### **ACTS 3 main parts**







## SERGIUS PAULUS



INSCRIPTION OF SERGIUS PAULUS, The proconsul in paphos. This Inscription was found in pisidian Antioch




#### Acts 13:7 Which was with the deputy of the country, Sergius Paulus

Archaeologists have also found evidence indicating Sergius Paulus was indeed a Roman governor of Cyprus. In 1877 an inscription was uncovered a short distance north of Paphos bearing Sergius Paulus's name and title of proconsul.


In addition, in 1887 his name was found on a memorial stone in Rome. On a boundary stone of Emperor Claudius, his name Sergius Paulus is found among others, as having been appointed (A.D. 47) one of the curators of the banks and the channel of the river Tiber. After serving his three years as proconsul at Cyprus, he returned to Rome, where he held the office referred to.






## 2 Tim 3:10-11
