# ACTS 17:11

Paul and Silas at Berea  
10 And the brethren immediately sent away Paul and Silas by night unto Berea who coming thither went into the synagogue of the Jews.

11 **These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.**

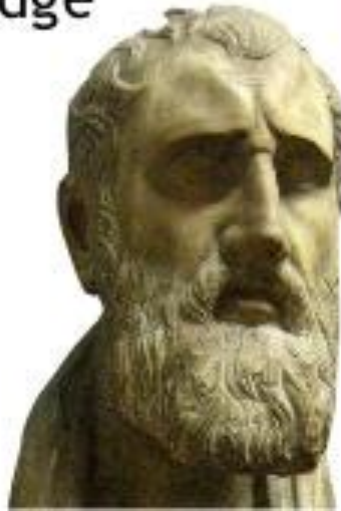




# NEW PHILOSOPHY

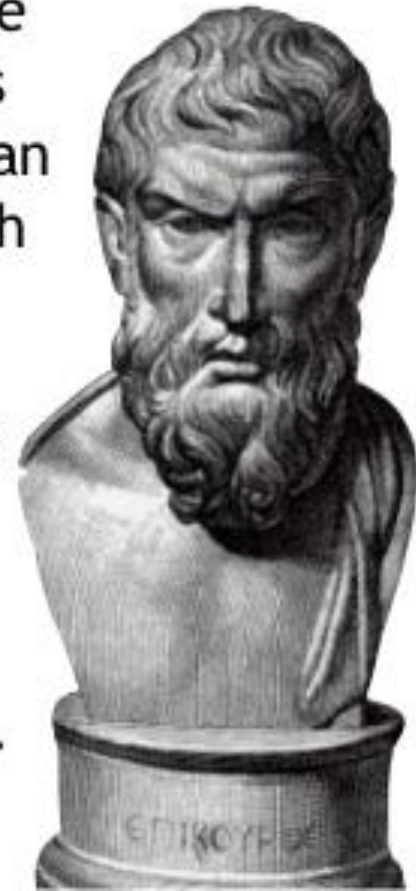
## STOICISM

# Areopagus (Mars Hill)







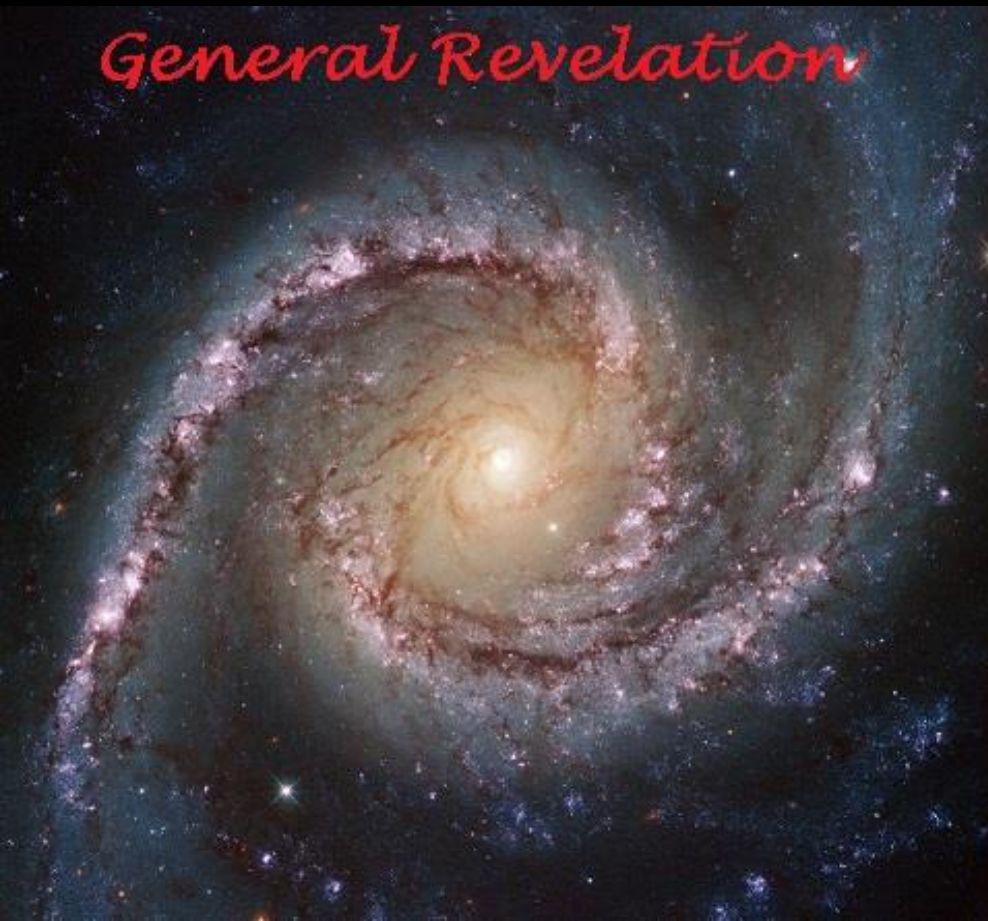




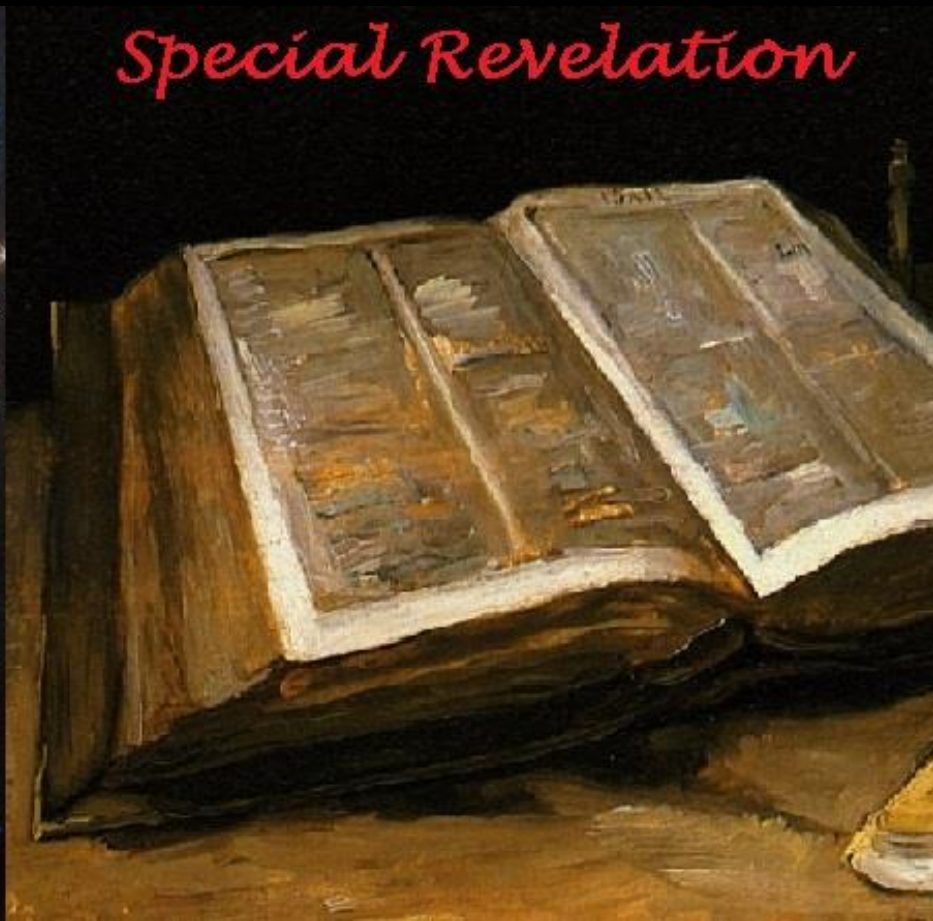
Altar to "the Unknown God"



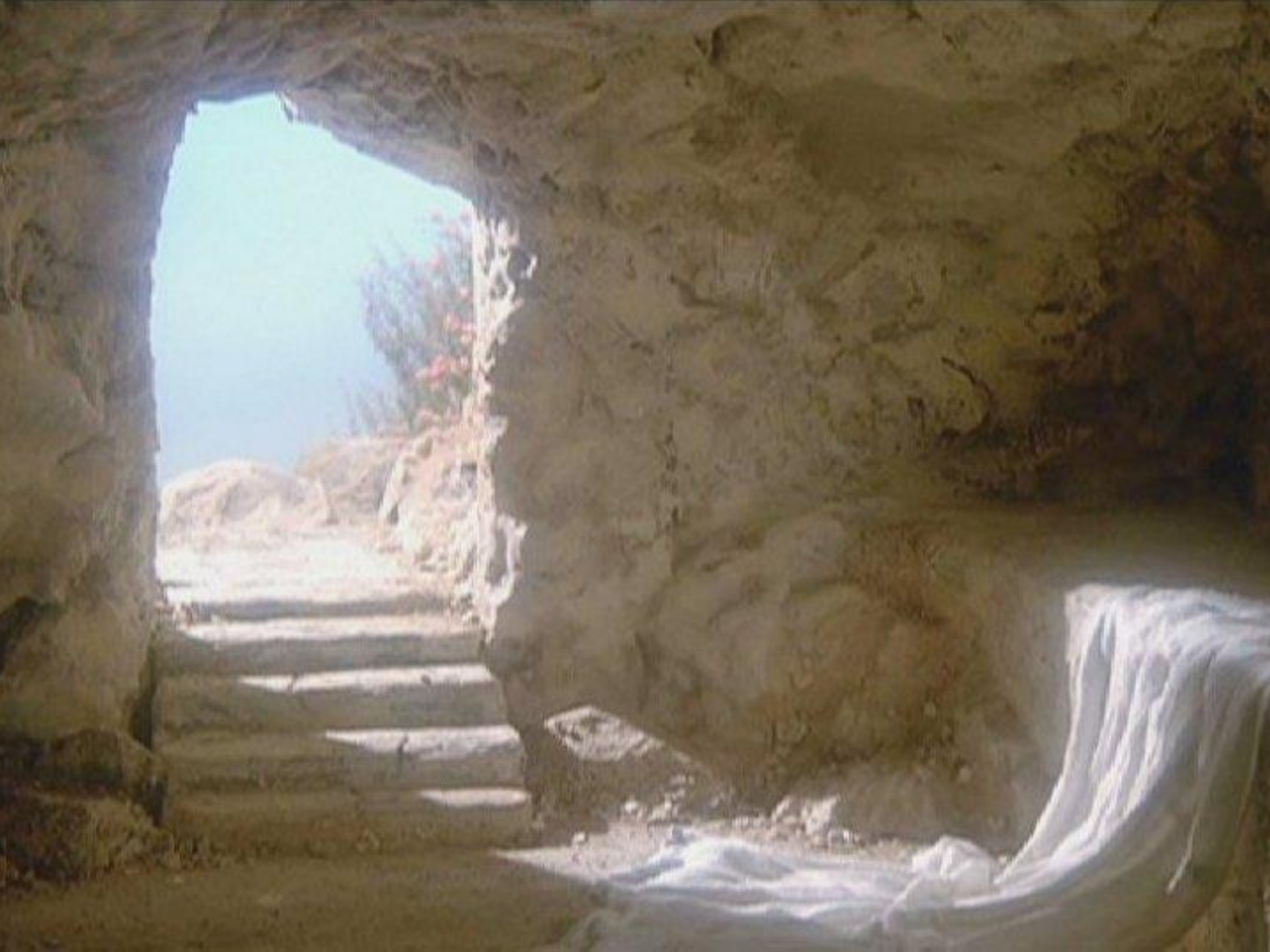
