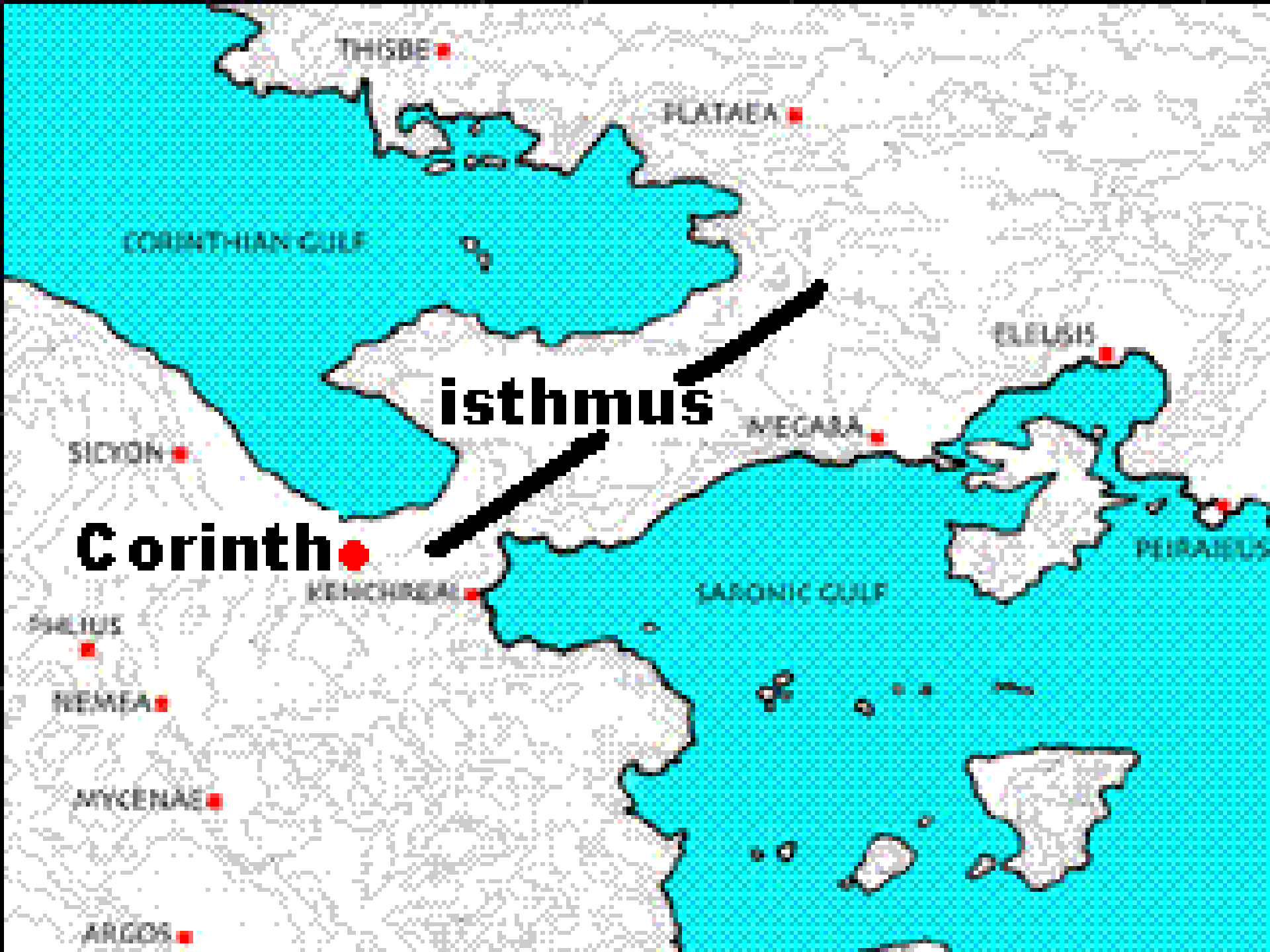

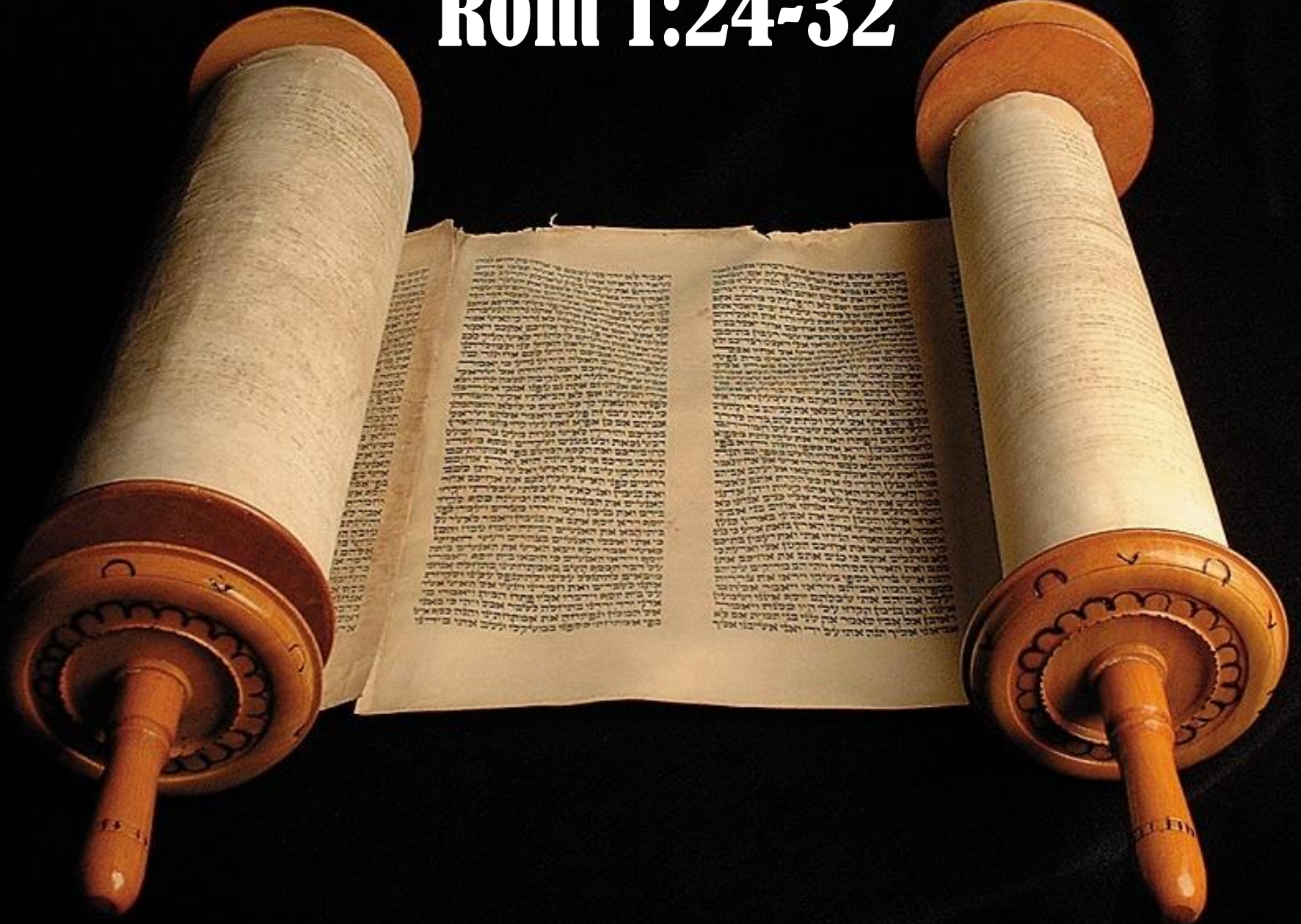
The Acropolis overlooking ancient Corinth



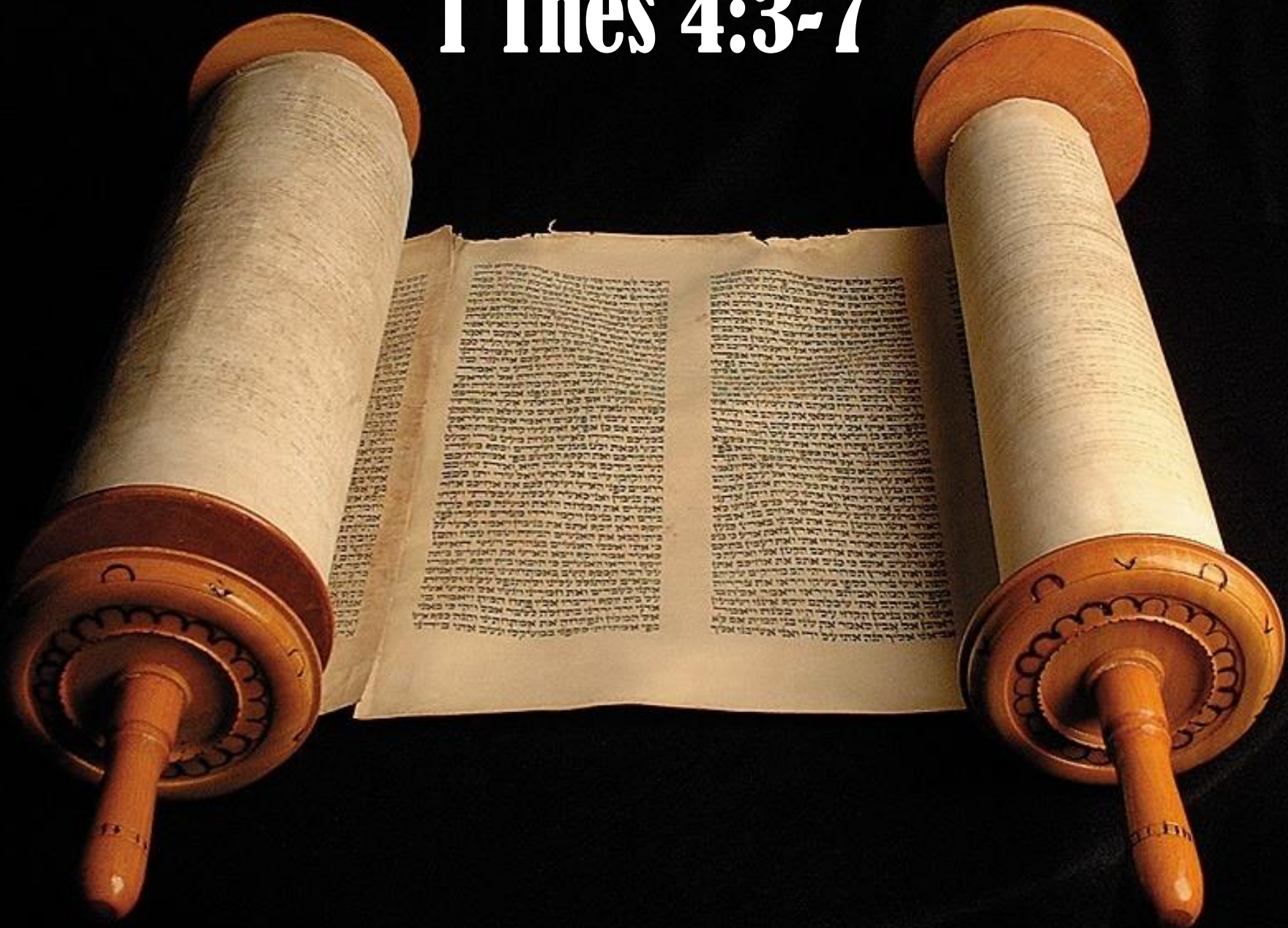

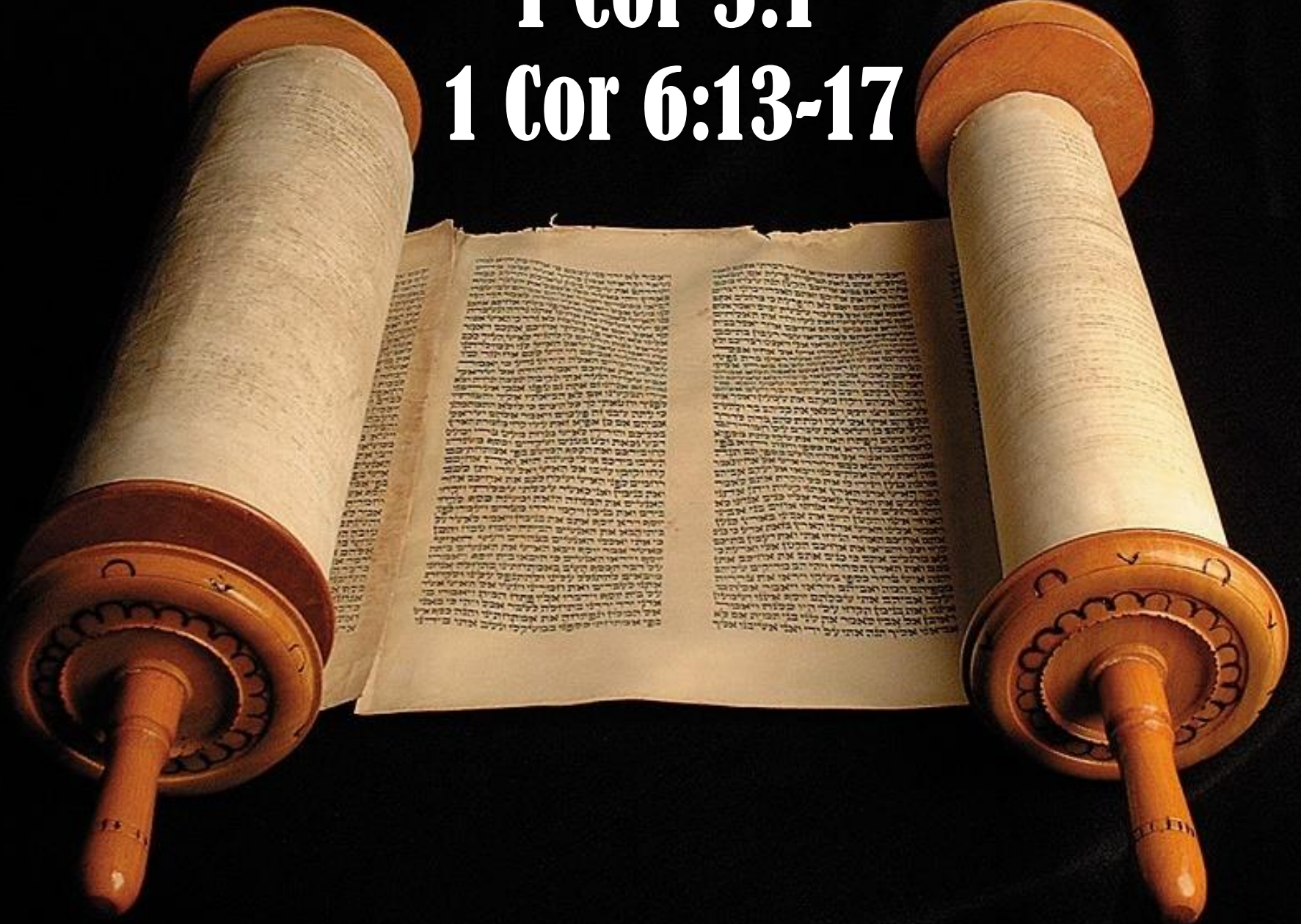
