


50 CHAPTERS ON THE TABERNACLE












































Heb 9:24 For Christ has not entered the holy places made with hands, which are copies of the true, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us

- **Heb 10:19** Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus,
- Heb 10:20 by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh,
- Heb 10:21 and having a High Priest over the house of God,
- Heb 10:22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith

Heb 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need



Ex 25:8 And let them make Me a sanctuary, that I may dwell among them

Ex 25:9 According to all that I show you, that is, the pattern of the tabernacle and the pattern of all its furnishings, just so you shall make it.

Ex 25:10 And they shall make an ark of acacia wood, two and a half cubits *shall be* its length, a cubit and a half its width, and a cubit and a half its height.

Ex 25:11 And you shall overlay it with pure gold, inside and out you shall overlay it, and shall make on it a molding of gold all around.



Ex 25:13 And you shall make poles *of* acacia wood, and overlay them with gold.

Ex 25:14 You shall put the poles into the rings on the sides of the ark, that the ark may be carried by them.

Ex 25:15 The poles shall be in the rings of the ark; they shall not be taken from it.

Ex 25:16 And you shall put into the ark the Testimony which I will give you.

Ex 25:17 You shall make a mercy seat of pure gold; two and a half cubits shall be its length and a cubit and a half its width.

Ex 25:18 And you shall make two cherubim of gold; of hammered work you shall make them at the two ends of the mercy seat.

Ex 25:19 Make one cherub at one end, and the other cherub at the other end; you shall make the cherubim at the two ends of it *of one piece* with the mercy seat.

- 2 Kings 19:15 God of Israel, the One who dwells between the cherubim Assyrians against Israel, Hezekiah prays
- Is 37:16 O LORD of hosts, God of Israel, that dwellest between the cherubs, thou art the God, even thou alone
- **Ps 80:1** Shepherd leads Israel, dwells between the cherubim



Ex 25:20 And the cherubim shall stretch out *their* wings above, covering the mercy seat with their wings, and they shall face one another; the faces of the cherubim *shall be* toward the mercy seat.

Ex 25:21 You shall put the mercy seat on top of the ark, and in the ark you shall put the Testimony that I will give you

Ex 25:22 And there I will meet with you, and I will speak with you from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubim which are on the ark of the Testimony, about everything which I will give you in commandment to the children of Israel.
